

Who Should receive the MMR vaccine?

- ~ Children 12 months and older should receive two doses of the MMR vaccine, separated by at least 4 weeks..
- ~ Adults born in 1957 or later who do not have medical contraindications should receive at least 1 dose of the MMR vaccine if they have no documentation of vaccination.
- ~ People who were vaccinated from 1963 through 1967 should receive 1 dose of the MMR

Adults at Increased Risk

- ~ College Students
- ~ Persons working in medical facilities
- ~ International travelers

Contraindications

- ~ Pregnancy
- ~ History of anaphylactic reactions to neomycin
- ~ Immunosuppression
