Call the Health Department and speak with a public health nurse who can provide guidance on caring for your sick loved one and make an appointment to pick-up your care kit. *Phone: 937-498-7249*

Please do not come inside the Health Department if you have had contact with someone with COVID-19. Care kit will be provided in your vehicle. *Health Department address: 202 W. Poplar St., Sidney, OH 45365*

Look for emergency warning signs for COVID-19. If someone is showing any of these signs, seek emergency medical care immediately:

- Trouble breathing;
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest;
- New confusion;
- Inability to wake or stay awake;
- Pale, gray, or blue-colored skin, lips, or nail beds, depending on skin tone.

This list is not all possible symptoms.

Please call your medical provider for any other symptoms that are severe or concerning to you.
