The Sidney-Shelby County Health Department is seeking a Public Health Harm Reduction Intern to support community-based harm reduction initiatives that promote health, safety, and access to resources for underserved populations. This internship offers hands-on experience in public health data practices, community outreach, health education, and program operations within a harm reduction framework.
